"I Wish We Knew About Divorce Mediation Sooner."

At MWI we often hear clients say, "I wish we knew about divorce mediation sooner." Some delayed starting the divorce process for fear it might be too overwhelming and some had previously spent money on other process options that did not have the results they had hoped for.

What Are Benefits of Divorce Mediation?

- Control over important decisions affecting you (and your children).
- Discovery of unique and appropriate ways to resolve areas of disagreement and interpersonal conflict.
- Greater likelihood that the terms of the agreement reached will be honored in the future.
- Less trauma for the children involved.
- Reduction of hostility between participants.
- Growth in the ability of each participant to assert him or herself and to understand, articulate, and provide for his or her own needs.
